



The *Heart* of Worship

Worship is non-musical:

- Isaac Model
- Jesus Model

Worship is non-liturgical:

- Worship service is a **culmination** of the life of worship lived throughout the week.
- Worship service is a **celebration** of the goodness and faithfulness of God.
- Worship service is an **expectation** of the week that lies ahead.

The *Start* of Worship

The **verbal** dynamic:

- sing, shout, speak, agreement, repetition

The **physical** dynamic:

- clap, dance, raised hands

The **emotional** dynamic:

- directing our will, submitting our will



Musicianship:

- Being prepared, not a distraction
- Being in tune with leader
 - a. Knowing/watching for cues
 - b. Paying attention for the “feel” in dynamics

Band & Vocals:

- Rhythm section being together (kick hits/bass licks)
- Vocals also working together (don't battle each other or the leader)
- “Filler/pad” instruments / vocal “licks” - knowing when to add and when to stay quiet.
- Realize that you, although “backup”, have control & need to understand how to use and utilize that control you have over the group.
- Importance of tempo and “solidness”.

In short:

You ready yourself as a musician to the point where you do not have to focus on technical side (playing, etc.), to where you can have FUN and worship.
